



Best Practices for Class Calls and Homework Calls

General Best Practices

- No gossiping. If you are found out to be talking about the school, the teachers or anyone in the program in a disparaging way, this is grounds for dismissal.
- No fixing. Everyone is coming to this program with a great amount of knowledge and experience. Giving suggestions is not allowed on the call or during home work. Please respect how much the other person knows. Also, use the time for animal communication to actually communicate and give the animal voice rather than sharing your expertise.
- Make this time a priority.
- Absolutely **NO driving** if you are on a call.

Live Zoom Class Calls

All times are Pacific time zone regardless of call start time - 11:00 am or 1:00 pm or 5:00 pm

Zoom Call access information is emailed the day of the call.

Best practices for Live Zoom Class calls:

- Arrive early to calls. If more than 3 minutes late for an Animal Education Teleseminar or 5 minutes on a Tuesday or Wednesday or Thursday call, do not join and wait for the recording.
- Use a landline whenever possible
- Always mute yourself (* 6 on the phone). Even the littlest noises are picked up and broadcast to everyone on the line.
- Make this learning time a priority - no multitasking. If Joan finds people have been on Facebook during a phone call, she will suspend them from phone calls.

Homework Calls for All Courses – Animal Mastery Program and Home Study Courses

Homework is an opportunity to create a supportive environment to continue to grow your intuitive/telepathic muscles. We are so fortunate to have great study partners in both our graduates and current students.

Partners

We will assign a partner to you.

When you get your partner, connect with each other by email and set up a time for your homework appointment.

In Animal Communication, partners are switched every 4 to 6 weeks.

In Energy Healing for Animals Home Study Course, partners stay together for the duration of the course.

Homework Guidelines

- Email a picture of one animal. Please ONLY ONE animal per homework session. You can set up other animals, or issues at a different time.

- Please do readings the same way we do in class. Wait until you are on the call with your partner to read the animal.
- Please be respectful of your partner, and treat/speak to them with the same kindness that you would hope for.
- DO NOT get into fixes for the animal. Be respectful of the path your homework partner is on and where they are with their animal.
- Students who have completed Death and Dying and/or Death and the Art of Crossing Over are the only ones with the prerequisite completed that is required to read animals who have crossed over.
- If you have only one animal or no animal, you can use a friend's animal. If you are using a friend's animal, then you need to either know the animal well enough to verify information or the owner needs to be on the call to verify information.

Homework Guidelines for EFT Tapping calls

- During your homework call (you may break it into two sessions if necessary) decide who will be doing the first tapping, as the TAPPER. The other person the “client”. Then switch.
- The tapper will review the client's story with them and create a script. The set-up phrase will be created out of the big emotions that are stated on the top of the sheet. The tapper will move through the emotions of the challenge. The tapper should feel into the client “shifts” before creating the desired outcome, the perfect world.
- You can give each other gentle, helpful feedback. Be honest if you have not had a shift. At that point, the tapper can jump in with another round of tapping to help the person really move the deep-seated emotion.
